2.	When I will be able to take printout of Registration Slip?	After minimum of two working days of depositing the fee in the bank.
3.	If the print out of the registration slip could not be taken. Can it be taken out at a later date?	Yes, The printouts of the registration slip can be taken at a later date. The link for taking printout of the registration slip is available on the website.
4.	Whether the registration number can be viewed again if the same has not been noted down at the time of submission of application?	Yes, The same can be retrieved from the website from the link mentioned in website by giving email-id and date of Birth.
5.	I am a graduate and applying for Customer Relations Assistant but I don't have computer literacy (Computer Application Course of a minimum 6 weeks duration course from reputed Computer Training Institute) on the date of application. Can I apply for Customer Relation Assistant post and obtain Computer Application Course of a minimum 6 weeks duration course after applying for this post?	Yes, You can apply for Customer Relations Assistant post and you can obtain Computer Application Course of a minimum 6 weeks duration course there after but the condition of making your application eligible for the post will be subject to production of proof of having passed eligibility qualification (Certificate in Computer Application Course of minimum 6 weeks duration) on the date of interview likely to be held tentatively by December'2016/ January'2017.
6.	I have done 4 years B.Tech/B.E. in Electrical/ Electronics/ Mechanical/ Civil Engineering, Can I apply for the post of Junior Engineer (Electrical/ Electronics/ Mechanical/ Civil)?	Yes.
7.	I have done 4 years B.Tech/B.E. in Electrical/ Electronics, Can I apply for the post of Station Controller/ Train Operator (SC/TO)?	Yes.
8.	Can the age of candidate be rounded off to the lower limit?	No, The age cannot be rounded off to the lower limit.
9.	When will the written test be held?	Schedule for Written Test/ Interview test will be notified only through DMRC website. The Candidates are advised to visit our website regularly pertaining to this Advt. Refer Selection Process column in the Advt for details.
10.	Whether NOC has to be obtained for applying by the applicants from Ex-Serviceman/PSUs/Govt. Departments?	Candidates from Ex-Serviceman/PSUs/Govt. Departments are required to obtain NOC. NOC will be verified at the time of interview for qualified candidates.
11.	Where will be the Written Test center?	Only in Delhi & NCR.
12.	Whether OBC certificate in the state government Proforma allowed?	No, OBC certificate should be in the format prescribed for employment under government of India and the same is given in the appendix II in the "Eligibility Criteria and Other Details" on the website.

13.	Can I apply for more than one post?	Yes, Candidates can apply for more than one post as per their qualifications. However, they must note that the written test for post codes E01, E02 & E03 can be held on one single day & written test for post codes E04, E05 & E06 on one single day and written test for post codes NE03, NE04, NE05 & NE06 may hold on one single day depending upon the volume of applications received. Written examination for remaining posts will be held on different dates. As such candidates applying for more than one post must keep this combination in mind.
14.	My final semester/year result is not declared. Can I apply?	Candidates who are appearing at the qualifying exam, passing of which would make them educationally eligible for these posts but have not yet been informed of the results, will also be eligible for applying for these posts. Such candidates will be admitted to the examination, if otherwise eligible, but their candidature would be deemed to be provisional and subject to cancellation , if they do not produce <u>proof of having passed the eligibility qualification on the date of Group Discussion/Interview/Psycho Test</u> which is likely to be held tentatively by December'2016/January'2017.
15.	For Account Assistant-- Which qualification is equivalent to B.Com?	BBA
16.	I have Degree/Diploma in Computer Science or IT. Whether Can I apply for SC/TO?	NO. Three years Engineering Diploma in Electrical/Electronic or equivalent or BSC Hons in (Physics/Chemistry/Maths) or BSc (Physics/Chemistry/Maths) from a Govt. recognized University/Institute.
